

Steps of Thesis Assessment in Wihi

Previous steps:

You have accepted phases 1/3 and 2/3, after which phase 3/3 will begin in Wihi. At the end of this phase, the thesis is assessed.



The approved grades have transferred from Wihi to Peppi for the Bachelor's and Master's Thesis Planning and the Bachelor's and Master's Thesis Implementation courses.



NB: The thesis must be returned to the Plagiarism Check field and the analysis must be approved for assessment to begin in Wihi.



The actual assessment begins :

The 2nd examiner (examiner in Wihi) will be selected for the thesis at this stage at the latest. His/her role is to review and assess the thesis from an outside and objective perspective.



The maturity test should be performed at this stage at the latest.



The principal thesis tutor and the 2nd examiner assess the work and prepare a statement together (includes the result of the Turnitin analysis).



The principal thesis tutor will record the assessment as final in Wihi. Phase 3/3 has been approved.



The information from the approved maturity test is transferred from Wihi to Peppi for the Bachelor's and Master's Maturity Test course.



The thesis is submitted to the thesis work group for assessment in the event that the thesis tutor and the 2nd examiner have not reached a unanimous evaluation decision.



The student saves his/her thesis to Theseus and adds a published thesis Theseus link to Wihi.



Completion of assessment and process:

The thesis tutor accepts the Theseus link provided by the student and at the same time archives the documents related to the thesis in PDF format.



Final thesis the numerical grade is transferred to all thesis courses as well as for the actual thesis. The thesis title (Finnish and English) will also be transferred to Peppi.
